Hi best art lovers!

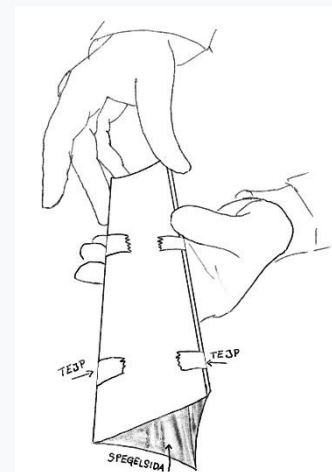
Right now, many exciting works of art are hanging at the art museum that have been created with the help of the camera. In one of the exhibitions we can see works of art by different artists who have photographed reality in different, exciting and unexpected ways. Among other things through super zooms, reflections and various filters.

Try it you too! Discover your surroundings in a new way with the help of a self-built kaleidoscope. You have everything you need in the paper bag.

How to build your kaleidoscope!

Tape the strips together with the mirror side inwards, so that a triangular tube is formed. Make sure the edges are snug together so that they are close against each other. Decorate your kaleidoscope as you wish. Hold it to one eye, like a pair of binoculars, and start looking around. You'll be surprised!

Tip! Hold the kaleidoscope in front of the camera lens of the mobile camera and discover the patterns and shapes that arise. Take a picture!
